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Kurt Busch Wins Again in Charlotte

Second Straight Week with Victory at Charlotte Motor Speedway

KENOSHA, Wis. – June 1, 2010 – After winning last week's NASCAR Sprint Cup All-Star race at the Charlotte Motor Speedway on May 22, Kurt Busch and his Snap-on sponsored Penske race team were primed for a repeat performance at the Coca-Cola 600 held at the same track on May 30. Busch did not disappoint as he took the checkered flag for the second week in a row.

"Although the Penske team did not do as well as they hoped at Indy, they sure had to be pleased with Kurt's performance in Charlotte later that day," said Alicia Smales, vice president of marketing for Snap-on Tools. "What an impressive display of racing for Kurt and the Penske team the last two weeks. It was the 11th win this year by a Snap-on sponsored driver, so we are thrilled with how the race season is going in 2010."

Busch is now in sixth place in the season-points standings with two first-place finishes and five, top-five finishes this year. Busch and the Penske NASCAR Sprint Cup race team will head to Pennsylvania for the Pocono 500 on June 6. The Snap-on Nationwide series drivers will be in Nashville on June 5 for the Federated Auto Parts 300.

As they have since 1980, Snap-on was heavily involved at the Indianapolis 500 providing the Penske Racing team with stationary storage and an assortment of Snap-on tools. Penske drivers Will Power (8) and Helio Castroneves (9) both finished in the top 10. Castroneves was on the pole for the fourth time in his career. The IRL and Team Penske will be back at the track on June 5 at the Texas Motor Speedway in Ft. Worth.

Cruz Pedregon and the Snap-on Funny Car, as well as the other Snap-on NHRA drivers, will compete this weekend in the Route 66 NHRA Nationals in Joliet, Ill., where Snap-on will host over 1,200 customers. Although he did not race the Snap-on Funny Car over the Memorial Day weekend, Pedregon did race the Snap-on late model No. 75 Snap-on dirt track car on May 30 at Eldora Speedway in Rossburg, Ohio. Pedregon won his heat in the Johnny Appleseed Classic in the Sunoco American Late Model Series and finished eighth in the final heat. He used that race as a tune-up for his appearance in the "Prelude to the Dream" charity race on June 9 at the same track.
