The Penske Racing IRL team will be competing August 22 at the Indy Grand Prix of Sonoma (Cal.) at the Infineon Raceway while Cruz Pedregon and the Snap-on Funny Car are off until the U.S. Nationals on Sept. 1-6 in Indianapolis.
