Snap-on Driver Brad Keselowski Wins NASCAR Sprint Cup Race in Kansas

Cruz Pedregon Second in Snap-on Funny Car at NHRA SuperNationals

KENOSHA, Wis. – June 6, 2011 – It was an exciting day of racing on June 5 for the Snap-on race team as Brad Keselowski captured the NASCAR Sprint Cup 400 at the Kansas Speedway while Cruz Pedregon drove the Snap-on Funny Car to a runner-up showing at the NHRA SuperNationals in Englishtown, N.J.

“We want to congratulate both Brad and Cruz on a great weekend of racing,” said Rick Secor, director of marketing communications for Snap-on Tools. “Because of Snap-on’s long association with Penske Racing, we are always thrilled when one of their drivers wins. Cruz has had a very consistent season with two runner-up showings and two other semifinal appearances and continues to put himself in great shape for the ‘Countdown to the Championship.’”

Keselowski, driving for the Penske Racing team, captured his first Sprint Cup win of the year and second of his career with the victory in Kansas City, Kan. It was the 67th career NASCAR Cup win for Penske Racing and the first of 2011. The Snap-on Sprint Cup drivers will be racing again this weekend in the Pocono (Pa.) 500 on June 12.

Pedregon continued his solid season by qualifying first for the second time in 2011 and reaching his second final of the year. Pedregon and the Snap-on Funny Car are off until they race at the Thunder Valley Nationals in Bristol, Tenn. June 17-19.

Although he has the week off from the NHRA, Pedregon will still be racing, competing in the annual “Prelude to the Dream” dirt track race for charity on June 8 at Eldora Speedway in Rossburg, Ohio. Pedregon will drive the No. 75 Snap-on late model dirt track car as he and his fellow all-star drivers race to raise money for children’s hospitals. The race will be presented live on HBO Pay-Per-View with proceeds from the telecast supporting Children’s Healthcare of Atlanta, Children’s Medical Center in Dallas, Levine Children’s Hospital in Charlotte and St. Louis Children’s Hospital. Pedregon will race for team “Levine” along with his teammates, Bill Elliott, Ray Evernham, Denny Hamlin, Jimmie Johnson and David Reutimann.
