The Blue-Point® Wheel Lift Assist works on passenger cars and light trucks. In addition to this, it works on 19.5 inch truck wheel and tire assemblies commonly found on medium duty vehicles. It can hold up to 130 pounds of tire/wheel weight, 24 to 36 inches in tire diameter range and can lift a tire/wheel over 29 inches high. It automatically adjusts for different tire sizes and helps the user in the alignment of tire and wheel assemblies to the hub studs easily.
