- Use of ¾-inch drive ratchet/torque wrench transmits the high torque necessary to loosen and tighten head bolts with less strain on the technician
- Eliminates the need to remove the truck/van cab from the chassis to access the rear head bolts, saving time and preventing damage to the rear heat shield
- Eliminates the need to remove the evaporator housing, saving two hours of time and the additional cost of refrigerant added during A/C recharging
- Coupled with an SWM181 18mm socket, the SRD35 can access all of the head bolts, eliminating the need to change tools or remove the adaptor during the job
