- Test results can be sent to either a Microsoft® PC (sold separately) via USB adapter (included), or a stand alone IR Printer (optional HHGA-5 or 2-22566)
- Test data for the last test performed is stored in the memory and can be reviewed either when connected to a battery or when disconnected from the battery at a later time
- Applications: Tests batteries from 100 CCA to 3500 CCA (battery pack); 6/12/24/36V starting/charging systems; both series and parallel batteries; parasitic drain; alternator ripple; 6V & 12V batteries
