Ryan Briscoe Captures IRL 550 in Texas; Brad Keselowski wins Third Nationwide Race of Season

KENOSHA, Wis. – June 7, 2010 – The wins keep piling up for Snap-on sponsored drivers as Ryan Briscoe captured the IRL 550 at the Texas Motor Speedway on June 5 while Brad Keselowski won his third Nationwide race of the season that same night. However, before he races in Englishtown, Pedregon will drive the late model No. 75 Snap-on dirt track car on June 9 in the "Prelude to the Dream" charity race at the Eldora Speedway in Rossburg, Ohio. Pedregon will be one of the more than 25 world-renowned drivers racing to raise money for four children's hospitals.

The all-star dirt late model race will be presented live on HBO Pay-Per-View with proceeds from the telecast supporting Riley Hospital for Children in Indianapolis, Cincinnati Children's, Levine Children's Hospital in Charlotte and St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in Memphis. Pedregon will be racing for team "Cincinnati Children's" along with his teammates: NASCAR stars Kasey Kahne, Joey Logano, Tony Stewart, Kevin Harvick and Bill Elliott.
