Snap-on Driver Will Power Captures IRL Grand Prix of Alabama

Cruz Pedregon and Snap-on Funny Car Head to Charlotte for Four-Wide Nationals this Weekend

KENOSHA, **Wis.** – **April 12**, **2011** – Snap-on sponsored driver Will Power started from the pole and never looked back as he captured the Indy Grand Prix of Alabama held April 10 at Barber Motorsports Park in Birmingham.

After starting on the pole for the second race in a row, Power led all 90 laps of the Birmingham race on his way to the win. Power and his Penske teammates, Ryan Briscoe and Helio Castroneves, will be racing again this weekend at the Grand Prix of Long Beach on April 17.

Cruz Pedregon and the Snap-on Funny Car will also be in action this weekend as they partake in the NHRA Four-Wide Nationals in Charlotte. Last September, Pedregon won at the second Charlotte race and is hoping for a repeat performance this spring. Pedregon is second in the Funny Car standings entering the Charlotte race.

"Charlotte is slowly becoming my favorite race track," said the two-time world champion Pedregon. "One reason is the track; it's the smoothest on the circuit and very fast. Secondly, I love the facility itself. It's awesome and, oh yeah, we won the race there last fall, so we're looking forward to taking this Snap-on Funny Car back to see what we can do."
