Snap-on Sponsored Brad Keselowski Wins Again in Sprint Cup

Third Victory in 2012 is Most Among NASCAR Drivers

KENOSHA, Wis. – July 3, 2012 – With his third win of the 2012 season at the June 30 Quaker State 400 at the Kentucky Speedway®, Snap-on sponsored Brad Keselowski moved into 10th place in the Sprint Cup standings. Keselowski is the only Sprint Cup driver to have won three times this season and is one of only two drivers who have won both a Nationwide and Sprint Cup race this year.
